

Title: Ambassador's Field Visit to Somali Region
Implementation of the Emergency Nutrition Project by UNICEF

On June 6th-7th, H.E. Mr. Shinichi Saida visited the project site of the 'Integrated Drought Emergency Response to Meet the Needs of Internally Displaced Persons and Host Communities in the Somali Region' implemented by UNICEF and funded by the Government of Japan in March 2018. The project's aim is to provide emergency nutrition services to severely malnourished children under five and adolescents, mothers and caregivers of infants and young children at 42 IDP sites and host communities.

This field visit also included by Ms. Gillian Mellsop, UNICEF country representative. She and H.E. Mr. Saida exchanged views on current humanitarian situations with Mr. Anwar Ali, Humanitarian Adviser to the President of the Somali Region, the deputy head of the Somali Regional Health Bureau and Gode Zonal Government officials.
