

## **Agreement for Japan Grant Aid for Water Supply Development in Tigray**

Ethiopia and Japan signed a grant agreement worth approximately USD 1.8 million on 2 August, 2018. Mr. Akira Uchida, Charge d'affaires, a.i. of the Embassy of Japan in Ethiopia, and H.E. Ato Admassu Nebebe, State Minister for Finance and Economic Cooperation, signed the Exchange of Notes for a Grant Assistance Project for “The Project for Water Supply Development with Solar Tandem Pump System in Tigray Regional State”.

The project will help to improve the basic water infrastructure in the Tigray region, promote the quality of water, and ensure water quality, thereby contributing to sustainable economic and social development by providing water supply related equipment (water supply pumps, solar panels, etc.) to the Ethiopian government.
