

Signing Ceremonies for  
“Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects”

On 14th December 2018, the signing ceremonies for Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) were held at the Embassy of Japan in Ethiopia in the morning and at Black Lion Hospital in the afternoon. Following 4 GGP projects were signed between the Embassy of Japan and respective organizations: 1) The Haro Shote Primary School Expansion Project with the Horo Woreda Education Office, 2) The Gunchire Primary School Construction Project with the Enemor and Ener Woreda Education Office, 3) The Vulnerable Elderly’s Shelter Construction Project with the Shashamene Town Administration Bureau and 4) The Black Lion Hospital Neurology and Emergency Departments Medical Equipment Improvement Project with the Black Lion Project. The total amount of the grants is approximately USD 4.5 million.
