

Completion Ceremony of the Japanese Language Courses for Beginners

On 26 December 2018, Mr. Akira Uchida, Deputy Chief of Mission of the Embassy of Japan, attended the Completion Ceremony of the Japanese Language Courses co-organized by the Center for African and Oriental Studies Addis Ababa University and the Kyoto University Africa Liaison Office, in the presence of Professor Dechassa Abebe, Director of Africa and Oriental Studies; Dr. Samuel Tefera, assistant professor and Asian Desk Coordinator of the Center for African and Oriental Studies; Dr. Hisada Shinichiro, representative of the Kyoto University's Africa Liaison Office; Mr. Wataru Sekii, instructor of the Japanese Culture and Japanese Language Education ; course representatives of the afternoon, evening and Saturday classes, and members of the 2018 graduating class.
