

Signing Ceremony for
“The Project for the Construction of School Blocks for Awash Primary School”
In Afar Regional State

On the 5th of March 2019, a signing ceremony for a project funded by the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) was held at the Embassy of Japan in Ethiopia. One contract was signed between the Embassy of Japan and Awash Sebat Kilo Town Administration Education Office for a GGP project entitled “The Project for Construction of School Blocks for Awash Primary School in Awash Fentale Woreda, Afar Regional State”. The grant is worth USD 89,280.

Under the project, two school buildings that contain eight classrooms will be constructed. Two hundred desks and four hundred chairs for the pupils and eight tables and chairs for the teachers will be provided, in addition to eight blackboards for each classroom. The old school building is made of iron because it is a former military facility, and is too hot for pupils to study in.

During the ceremony, H.E. Mr. Daisuke Matsunaga, Ambassador of Japan to Ethiopia, mentioned that the Embassy of Japan has implemented over 400 projects all over Ethiopia under the GGP scheme and that he expressed his hope that the project would be completed swiftly and smoothly.
