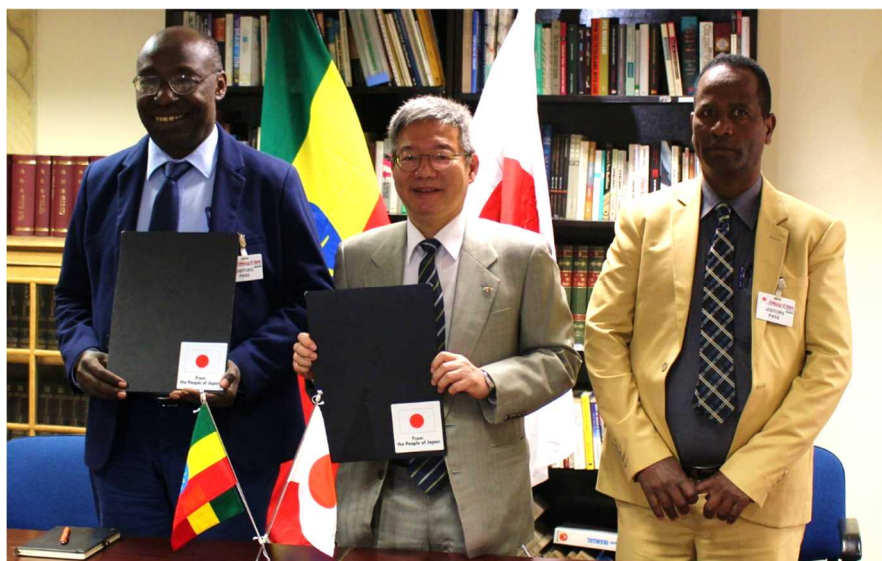
At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Matsunaga said that he hopes that this project will be helpful for the local community and will be implemented smoothly.
