

Signing ceremony for “The project for upgrading Shambu primary school, Horo Guduru Wollega Zone, Oromia”

The grant contract signing ceremony for “The project for upgrading Shambu primary school, Horo Guduru Wollega Zone, Oromia” through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), was held on 23 January 2020 in the presence of H.E Mr. Matsunaga Daisuke, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia. This grant contract amounts to USD 85,755 for Shambu Town Education Office.

At Shambu primary school, each classroom currently holds about 80 children. This is over capacity, and the school's children are forced to study in a poor educational environment. This project is to improve the educational environment by constructing new school buildings (2 school buildings and 8 classrooms).

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Matsunaga explained that Japan has implemented more than 400 GGP projects in Ethiopia, and said that he hopes that this project will be implemented smoothly.
