

Signing Ceremony for “The Project for the Construction of Lich Googo Secondary School in Kidigsa Kebele, Lemo Woreda, Hadiya Zone, SNNPRS”

The grant contract signing ceremony for “The Project for the Construction of Lich Googo Secondary School in Kidigsa Kebele, Lemo Woreda, Hadiya Zone, SNNPRS”, to be implemented through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), was held on 23 September, 2020 in the presence of H.E. Dr. Ergogie Tesfaye, Minister of Labor and Social Affairs, H.E Mr. Matsunaga Daisuke, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia, and Dr. Habtamu Abebe, the President of Wachemo University signed the grant agreement. This grant contract amounts to approximately USD 123,000, equivalent to nearly 4,500,000 Birr. Under this project, one new school building with four classrooms will be constructed at the Lich Googo Secondary School, enabling students to study in an appropriate environment.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Matsunaga said that Japan is pleased “to be able to assist in improving the educational environment of the students at Lich Googo Secondary School, and explained that Japan had implemented more than 400 GGP projects in Ethiopia.
