

Signing ceremony for “The Project for the Construction of a Public Library in Gacheno Kebele, Damot Gale Woreda, Wolayita Zone, SNNPRS”

The grant contract signing ceremony for “The Project for the Construction of a Public Library in Gacheno Kebele, Damot Gale Woreda, Wolayita Zone, SNNPRS” through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), was held on 6 October 2020 in the presence of H.E Mr. Hailemariam Dessalegn, Former Prime Minister of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia; H.E Mr. Matsunaga Daisuke, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia; and Ms. Roman Tesfaye, Former First Lady and CEO of the Hailemariam & Roman Foundation. This grant contract amounts to approximately USD 88,600, equivalent to nearly 3,200,000 Birr. Under this project, a public library and one vocational training building will be constructed in Gacheno Kebele and the implementation of this project will enable the community to have an appropriate reading, learning and training environment.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Matsunaga congratulated the Hailemariam & Roman Foundation on receiving the grant, and stated “I believe this project will create more educational opportunities and create a bright future for pupils, students and the wider public.”
