

Signing ceremony for “The Project for Construction of Library and Teachers' Rooms of Temenja Yaj Primary School, Kirkos Sub-city, Addis Ababa”

Japan signed a grant contract for “The Project for Construction of Library and Teachers' Rooms of Temenja Yaj Primary School, Kirkos Sub-city, Addis Ababa”, implemented through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). The signing of the grant contract was held on 10 December 2020, in the presence of H.E Ms. ITO Takako, Ambassador-Designate Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia, and Mr. Abate Kelbe, the Principal of the Temenja Yaj Primary School. Japan has donated up to USD 90,158, equivalent to 3,400,000 birr, for this project.

Under this project, one new building with a library floor and five teachers’ rooms with furniture will be constructed at the Temenja Yaj Primary School. This project will enable the students and teachers to study and work in a better environment and contribute to the improvement of the growth of education.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Ito stated that Japan has implemented more than 400 GGP projects in Ethiopia, and congratulated the representatives from the school on the signing of the project.
