

Signing Ceremony for “The Project for Expansion of Garment Training Center in Selam Children’s Village, Yeka Sub City, Addis Ababa”

Japan signed a grant contract for “The Project for Expansion of Garment Training Center in Selam Children’s Village, Yeka Sub City, Addis Ababa”, implemented through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). The signing of the grant contract was held on 27 January 2021, in the presence of H.E Ms. ITO Takako, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia, and Mr. Solomon Chali, General Manager of Selam Children’s Village. Japan has donated up to USD 70,387, equivalent to 2,800,000 birr, for this project.

Under this project, one vocational training building will be constructed and furnished at the Garment Training Center in Selam Children’s Village. This project will contribute to young and female trainees acquiring job skills and obtaining jobs through expanding the capacity of garment training. Also, Selam Children’s Village will receive a donation of 10 (ten) sewing machines from a company in Japan, the Yamato Sewing Machine Manufacturing. Co., Ltd, upon completion of the vocational training building.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Ito stated that Japan has implemented more than 400 GGP projects in Ethiopia, and congratulated the representatives from the school on the signing of the contract.
