

Signing Ceremony for “The Project for Expansion of Dalota Pre-Primary School in Galan Town, Oromia Special Zone, Oromia”

Japan signed a grant contract for “The Project for Expansion of Dalota Pre-Primary School in Galan Town, Oromia Special Zone, Oromia”, implemented through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). The signing ceremony of the grant contract was held on 28 January 2021, in the presence of H.E Ms. ITO Takako, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia, and Mr. Ahmed Idris, Mayor of Galan Town. Japan has donated up to USD 89,944, equivalent to 3,500,000 birr, for this project. Under this project, one block of four classrooms, a toilet block and furniture will be provided at the Dalota Pre-Primary School. This project will enable more children to learn in a proper learning environment, as well as to be in the improved sanitary condition.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Ito expressed her hope that the project will help build a brighter future for children in Galan Town, where the population has been increasing rapidly, through enhanced quality of education.
