

Inauguration Ceremony for the the Construction of the Gunchire Primary School in Enemore and Ener Woreda, Guraghe Zone, SNNPR

On 24 February 2021, an inauguration ceremony was held for the Construction of the Gunchire Primary School in Enemore and Ener Woreda, Guraghe Zone, SNNPR.

In total, USD 99,402 was provided by Japan's Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) to support the construction of two classroom blocks containing eight classrooms with furniture, one latrine block, one water tank and a hand wash facility.

This project enables 192 new students to enroll and a total of 400 students to learn in the new classrooms.

In her congratulatory remarks, H.E. Ambassador ITO stated, "Children are the foundation for the future development of a country. Providing basic education for children is not only for the development of children, but also an important investment for the country's future. I believe this project will improve the quality of education and provide a bright future for the children in Gunchire Primary School".
