

Signing Ceremony of Projects for Expansion of Kololo Primary School in Kololo Kebele, Tembaro Woreda, Kembata-Tembaro Zone, SNNPR and Expansion of Yuwo Secondary School in Aruma Kebele, Wondo Genet Woreda, Sidama Region

On 16 September 2021, a signing ceremony was held at the residence of the Japanese Ambassador to Ethiopia for the projects for “Expansion of Kololo Primary School in Kololo Kebele, Tembaro Woreda, Kembata-Tembaro Zone, SNNPR” and “Expansion of Yuwo Secondary School in Aruma Kebele, Wondo Genet Woreda, Sidama Region.”

The total amount of these projects is up to USD 173,810. These projects will support the construction of three school furnished buildings. Kololo primary school will have one furnished block which allows 150 more students to study, while Yuwo Secondary School will have two furnished classroom blocks which can accept 200 more students.

In her remarks, Ambassador ITO stated that she expected new school buildings would help children to feel happy to come to school and enjoy learning as providing basic education is for a country’s future. Mr. Yenebeb Getachew, Country Director of The Tesfa Foundation and Mr. Biniyam Belachew, Exective Director of Resurrection and Life Development Organization expressed their appreciation for Japan’s support.
