

Signing Ceremony of Projects for Expansion of KUSURA Primary School in Kusura Kebele, Amibara Woreda, Afar Region and Construction of Library in Adea Model Secondary School, Bishoftu Town, East Shoa Zone, Oromia Region

On 24 September 2021, a signing ceremony was held at the residence of the Japanese Ambassador to Ethiopia for the projects for “Expansion of KUSURA Primary School in Kusura Kebele, Amibara Woreda, Afar Region” and “Construction of Library in Adea Model Secondary School, Bishoftu Town, East Shoa Zone, Oromia Region.”

The total amount of these projects is up to USD 163,735, and these projects will support the construction of two furnished school buildings and one library for a school. 8 more classrooms will be added and up to 400 more students can be completely accommodated at KUSURA primary school, while Adea model secondary school will have one library which can accept 100 students at the same time.

In her remarks, Ambassador ITO stated that she expected these projects were completed as swiftly as possible so that children could start learning in a new and improved environment. Mr. Guret Ahamed, Founder and Executive Director of Friendship Support Association, expressed his appreciation for Japan’s support.
