

Contract Signing Ceremony for “The Project for the Improvement of Equipment for Road Maintenance in Addis Ababa City”

On 25 July 2022, the contract signing ceremony for “The Project for the Improvement of Equipment for Road Maintenance in Addis Ababa City” was held at Addis Ababa City Hall.

Through this project, Japan will provide road maintenance and management equipment worth 13.86 billion yen (approximately 10 million USD) from Japan. The project is expected to improve the condition of the roads in combination with the technical cooperation project that has been carried out from 2015 to 2019.

At the signing ceremony, Ambassador Ito said, "Roads connect people and contribute to economic development. The project will also benefit visitors to the city, which is the diplomatic capital of Africa." Ms. Adanech Abiebie, Mayor of Addis Ababa City, expressed her gratitude for the support of the Japanese government, saying, "With the support from the Japanese government, we will be able to provide an efficient transportation system. Then, the signing between FutureBud International, a provider, and Addis Ababa City Roads Authority, the recipient of the grant was presented.
