

Japan Continues Support for Expanding Gender Sensitive Services with UNFPA

On 20 February 2023, Ambassador ITO Takako visited the Amhara Regional State and attended the event for the project “Addressing Gender-Based Violence (GBV) and Sexual Reproductive Health (SRH) in selected conflict and COVID-19 affected districts in Amhara and Benishangul-Gumuz Regions” funded by the Japanese Government and implemented by UNFPA.

The project aims to ensure timely access to life-saving GBV/SRH information and services for vulnerable women, girls and youth through trainings for health workers and provision of medical equipment, ambulances, reproductive health (RH) kits and female dignity kits.

During the event, RH kits were handed over to Tilili Health Center which is one of the health facilities supported under the project, and female dignity kits were handed over to some beneficiaries. Additionally, Japan committed to continue providing support and signed an agreement with UNFPA to implement the next project phase.
