

MEXT Scholarship 2024 Screening Process

On 27 and 28 June 2023, the selection of Embassy-recommended MEXT (Japanese government) scholarship 2024 was held. This year, 355 applicants (305 for research, 40 for undergraduate and 10 for technical college) applied, and 27 candidates who passed the document screening took a written examination and an interview during the above two days.

The MEXT Scholarship Programme aims to contribute to the promotion of international exchange and friendship and the development of human resources in other countries by accepting outstanding international students from overseas, and to contribute to the advancement of internationalisation of Japanese universities and other institutions, the improvement of education and research capabilities through this, and the internationalisation and revitalisation of society as a whole, thereby contributing to the development of our country and the world. The purpose of this system is to contribute to the development of Japan and the world. All procedures for the MEXT Scholarship students are carried out through Japanese embassies abroad or universities in Japan.
