On 28 August 2023, an inauguration ceremony was held for "the Project for Construction of Library in Adea Model Secondary School, Bishoftu Town, East Shewa Zone, Oromia Region" at the said school.

In total, USD 87,793 was provided by the Japanese Government through its Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) to construct one furnished library block with chairs and desks for 100 people as well as 15 bookshelves.
