

Inauguration Ceremony of Project for Expansion of Jigjiga Medical Worker Vocational Training Center in Somali Region

On 21 November 2023, an inauguration ceremony was held at Jigjiga Health Science College for the project for “Expansion of Jigjiga Medical Worker Vocational Training Center in Somali Region”.

With the total amount of this project is up to USD 86,584 through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), Japan supported one vocational training center with four classrooms and one warehouse, and one latrine building for 240 new college students. This project will improve the capabilities of midwives and nurses, and create a better learning environment for medical workers in Jigjiga Town.

In her remarks, Ambassador ITO stated that she believed that this new vocational training center will make an important role in Jigjiga town and graduates from the college will work actively in the town to help a lot of people who are in need of medical services.
