

Launching Ceremony for “Project for Expansion of Teferi Kela Primary School in Sidama Region”

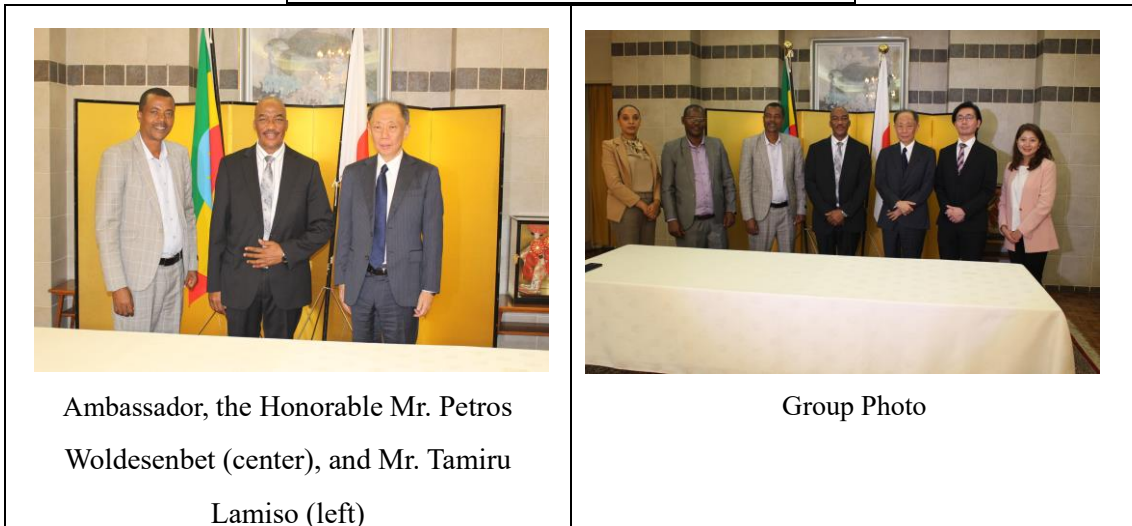
On 24 April 2024, the Embassy of Japan held a launching ceremony for the “Project for the Expansion of Teferi Kela Primary School in Dara Otilicho Woreda, Sidama Region” under the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) in the presence of H.E Mr. Shibata Hironori, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to Ethiopia, together with Mr. Tamiru Lamiso, Dara Otilicho Woreda Education Office Head, and the Honorable Mr. Petros Woldesenbet, FDRE, HoF, Identity, Administrative Boundary & Peace Building Directorate Director.

The total amount of the project is up to approximately USD 70,000, and this project will support the construction of one furnished school building with four classrooms in Sidama Region. The project will enable 200 additional students to study at the school.

At the ceremony, Ambassador Shibata addressed that education sector, which is the foundation of a nation, is one of areas that the government of Japan has been focusing on the most, and that the project will align with SDGs and Ethiopian government’s Growth and Transformation Plan II. He also expressed his gratitude for the cooperation with the Honorable Mr. Petros Woldesenbet who has been contributed relationship between Ethiopia and Japan, and expressed his hope that more children will have access to education and it will lead Ethiopia towards a brighter future.
