

Handover Ceremony of The Project for the Expansion of the Teferi Kela Primary School in Dara Otilicho Woreda, Sidama Region

On 18 February 2025, a handover ceremony was held at the Teferi Kela Primary School for the project entitled “Expansion of the Teferi Kela Primary School in Dara Otilicho Woreda, Sidama Region”.

With the approximately USD 70,000 grant funded by the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP), Japan supported the construction of one school building with 4 classrooms and school furniture. This expansion will enable around 1,800 existing students to learn in a better learning environment, which also enable 200 new students to enroll at the school.

In her remarks, Ms HORI Kaori, Second Secretary of the Embassy of Japan expressed her hope that this project will improve the quality of education and provide a brighter future for the children of the Teferi Kela Primary School.
